- birth 1. Rodion Romanovitch Raskolnikov—the central character sometimes referred to as Rodya or Rodka but most often as Raskolnikov
- 2. Audotya Romanovna Raskolnikov—Raskolnikov's sister who is simply called soul Dounia (doub/dont) breathe
 - 3. Pulcheria Alexandrovna Raskolnikov-Raskolnikov's mother
- marmelale. Marmeladov—an alcoholic who meets Raskolnikov in a bar

- Catherine 5. Katerina Ivanovna—Marmeladov's wife who has tuberculosis

 6. Sonia—Marmeladov's daughter who is a prostitute

 Peter the 7. Pyotr Petrovitch Luzhin—wealthy, middle-aged man who is engaged to marry

 Douris He is referred to as Luzhin Dounia. He is referred to as Luzhin.
- (right) 8. Dmitri Prokofitch Razumihin—Raskolnikov's loyal friend from the university. He reason is called Razumihin throughout the novel.
 - 9. Arkady Ivanovitch Svidrigailov—Dounia's former boss who tried to seduce her
 - 10. Marfa Petrovna—Svidrigailov's wife who is rumored to have been killed by him. She read Dounia's letter to the entire village.
 - 11. Alyona Ivanovna—the pawnbroker whom Raskolnikov kills
 - 12. Lizaveta Ivanovna—the pawnbroker's half-sister also killed by Rodya
 - 13. Porfiry Petrovitch—the brilliant, unconventional detective who becomes a formidable adversary to Raskolnikov
 - 14. Praskovya Pavlovna—Raskolnikov's landlady who reports him to the police
 - 15. Nastasya—the landlady's servant
 - 16. Ilya Petrovitch—a police officer
 - 17. Zametov—a clerk at the police station (zametož)
 18. Nikodim Fomitich—Chief of Police

 - 19. Zossimov—a doctor who treats Raskolnikov
 - 20. Dmitri and Nikolay—painters who were working at the pawnbroker's apartment building on the day of the murders
 - 21. Lebeziatnikov—the man who lives in the same building as the Marmeladov family. He later exposes Luzhin's framing of Sonia.
 - 22. Amalia Fyodorovna—Katerina Ivanovna's landlady

CAST OF CHARACTERS

Rodion Romanovitch Raskolnikov The main character who is alternately called Rodya, Rodenka, and Rodka.

Avdotya Romanovna Raskolnikov Rodya's sister, alternately called Dounia.

Pulcheria Alexandrovna Raskolnikov Rodya's mother.

Semyon Zakharovitch Marmeladov A drunkard who figures prominently in a bar conversation with Raskolnikov.

Katerina Ivanovna The wife of Marmeladov.

Sofya Semyonovna Marmeladov Marmeladov's daughter and devoted stepdaughter of Katerina Ivanovna, who prostitutes herself and later falls in love with Raskolnikov. Also called Sonia.

Arkady Ivanovitch Svidrigaïlov Dounia's former employer who arrives in St. Petersburg.

Marfa Petrovna Svidrigaïlov's wife who dies and leaves Dounia a bundle of needed money.

Pyotr Petrovich Luzhin A rich man who thinks he can buy happiness for Dounia, his love. His name, comically, means "puddle."

Dimitri Prokofitch Razhumikin Raskolnikov's best friend and guardian of Dounia.

Andrei Semyonovitch Lebeziatnikov A tenant in the same building as the Marmeladovs and a liberal.

Porfiry Petrovich The overseeing police officer on Raskolnikov's case.

Alyona Ivanovna The moneylender who Raskolnikov murders.

Lizaveta Ivanovna The simple-minded sister of Alyona and a friend of Sonya.

Praskovya Pavlovna Raskolnikov's complaining landlady who is owed back-rent.

Nastasya Praskovya's servant and a friend of Raskolnikov.

Amalia Fyodorovna The Marmeladov's landlady who causes a big scandalous fight at a dinner party.

Kapernaumov Sonia's landlady.

Zossimov A friend of Razhumikin and a doctor who cared for Raskolnikov.

Nikodim Fomitch Chief of the police.

Zametov A clerk in the police station and a fiend of Razhumikin.

Ilya Petrovitch A police official.

Nikolav and Dimitri The painters, one of whom admits to the crime.
